
Equity is an important principle in education. At its core, equity is about understanding what individual students need and committing to meeting those needs.

This presentation focuses on efforts and future-focused initiatives undertaken by RCPS that address equity in four key areas:


- Access to postsecondary opportunities

Student Population Percentages by Ethnic Subgroups 2023-24





KDOW Timeline











Allows Access for All Students

- All students have access to additional help, regardless of the school's ability to find additional instructional tutors
- Students have on-demand access and are not dependent on their parents to provide additional tutorial help
- Tutors are available 24 hours a day and also speak Spanish
- Builds self-confidence for students
- Students are also able to submit writing samples and receive feedback to extend their writing

Provides a Safe Place for Student Support

- All sessions are recorded
- Students have the option to speak with a tutor or communicate via text
- Tutors are thoroughly vetted by Princeton Review
- School system is notified immediately if students share any commentary that is alarming
